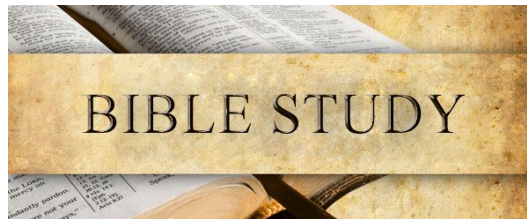
### **Mission Central**

## **Human Relations Day Offering ~ January 15**

An offering envelope is included in your pack of Sunday Offering envelopes.

As we celebrate the promise and potential of a new year, let us not forget those living in the margins of society — those who have lost hope.

Human Relations Day on Jan. 15 offers us an opportunity to change their outlook. When we join thousands of other United Methodists across the U.S. in a special offering, we become a voice for the voiceless (Proverbs 31:8) and shine a light on the overlooked and ignored (Matthew 25).

Our Special Sunday offering provides grants which support advocacy, community development and at-risk youth.

Consider the story of 85-year-old Emma Wooten, whose home was falling apart around her. She had tried to insulate her water-damaged walls with cereal boxes. Ceilings buckled under a leaky roof. Electrical wiring was unsafe. Through Partners in Ministry (PIM), a team from Canaan United Methodist Church in Winston-Salem, North Carolina, showed up at her doorstep with the tools and time needed to repair her dilapidated home.

"The team and our coordinators were extremely blessed by Emma's love, thankfulness and faith in God," said the Rev. Anna Troy, outreach coordinator for Partners in Ministry, a Human Relations Day Sunday grant recipient.

In addition to helping with home repairs for the elderly, disabled and others in need, the ministry sows community gardens, provides after-school programs for at-risk youth and serves as a family resource center. Partners in Ministry and its community of volunteers truly bring hope and change to an entire community.

This ministry is one reason we raise money for Human Relations Day. With our support of Human Relations Day offerings other ministries, such as Partners in Ministry, can receive grants that will continue nurturing at-risk youth, strengthening communities' self-improvement efforts and advocating for the oppressed.

When we give on Human Relations Day, we effect change today and for generations to come.
