If interested in being a part of this, the next meeting date is February 9.

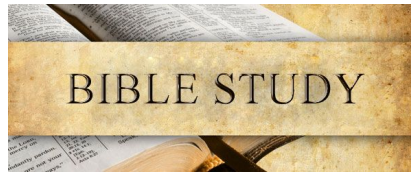
We meet in the church parking lot and leave promptly at 8 am. We work from 9-12 and then leave to go home. Sign up sheets are at the information center.
