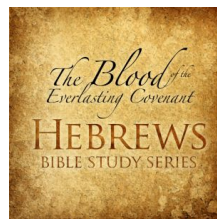
REGARDING NEWSLETTER AND BULLETIN COMMUNICATION

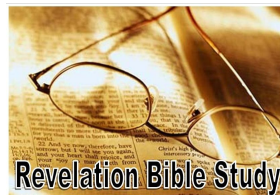
If interested in being a part of this, the next meeting date is March 9.
