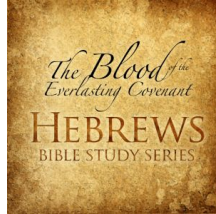

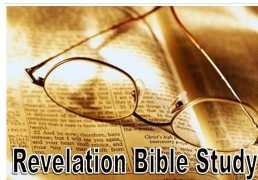
If interested in being a part of this, the next meeting date is March 9.

The trip is tentatively scheduled for September 22-28, give or take a day or two.

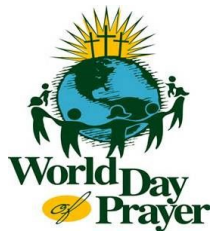
