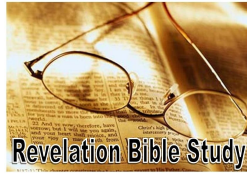
## **REGARDING NEWSLETTER AND BULLETIN COMMUNICATION**

## UMCOR Mission Moment

When Hurricane Matthew struck in 2016, UMCOR worked with families, many of whom were sleeping in hastily constructed structures. These huts were in front of piles of rubble of their former homes.” The town of Port-Salut on the southwestern-most tip of Haiti was hard hit. In one weekend, UMCOR Haiti provided 500 people with food, cooking kits, tarpaulins, and other necessary supplies. This distribution process took three days because the team sought out hard-hit impoverished communities and conducted house-to-house surveys to identify the needs of the most vulnerable people. Shortly after the 2010 earthquake that destroyed much of the Haiti, UMCOR opened a country office. We will celebrate UMCOR Sunday/One Great Hour of Sharing on March 26 with a special offering to support the continuing work of UMCOR.

*During the last four months of recovering from a severely broken ankle, I have been overwhelmed by the prayers and caring that have been shown to me and my husband, John. For cards, calls and gifts and visits, especially Sue and Pastor Garvin. I can feel prayers. They were important to me in keeping me cheerful and upbeat, causing me to have been a model patient! There have been so many blessings, quick help, an excellent surgeon, good nursing care both in the hospital and here at Normandie Ridge, and fantastic therapists. I am presently working on being weaned from a boot. The therapists tell me I will end up stronger than I was when all this happened.*
