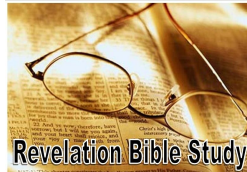
## **REGARDING NEWSLETTER AND BULLETIN COMMUNICATION**

### **Disaster Relief**

UMCOR brings God's hope, healing and renewal to people whose lives have been disrupted by war, conflict or natural disaster. UMCOR provides humanitarian relief and disaster response to people in more than 80 countries, including the United States. UMCOR provides survivors not only temporary relief, but also long-term education, training, and support.

UMCOR also provides resources in refugee camps where families flee for safety from political conflicts or because of natural disaster such as drought and famine.

### **Global Health**

Improving global health is one of the many ways the United Methodist Committee on Relief seeks to do the work of God in the world. Interrupting the cycles of poverty that contribute to malnutrition and hunger is one specific way that UMCOR works to improve global health.

Nearly 1,000 children die each day from hunger, but it sometimes may seem a concern that is far from home. The truth is that hunger is even closer than some of us realize, as 14.3% of the total United States population lives in poverty, including one in five children. ### **Sustainable Recovery and Development**
