Native American Ministries Sunday - April 30

Next Sunday, we will be celebrating Native American Ministries Sunday. 50% of the offering will stay within our Susquehanna Conference to develop and strengthen local Native American ministries. Rev. Larry Siikanen leads the Native American Ministries Committee in our conference.

The remaining 50% will go toward seminary scholarships for Native American students as well as nurturing mission with Native Americans in urban areas. Many Native American churches have been blessed to receive grants for items such as hymnals, Bibles, children's ministries and handicap access renovation.

The United Methodist Church has a strong relationship with Native Americans. There are 149 Native American United Methodist Churches. In the United Methodist church there are 21,365 Native American members.
