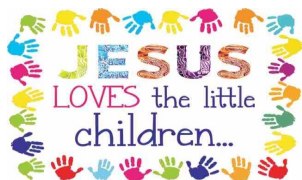

Week 5: God's Priorities

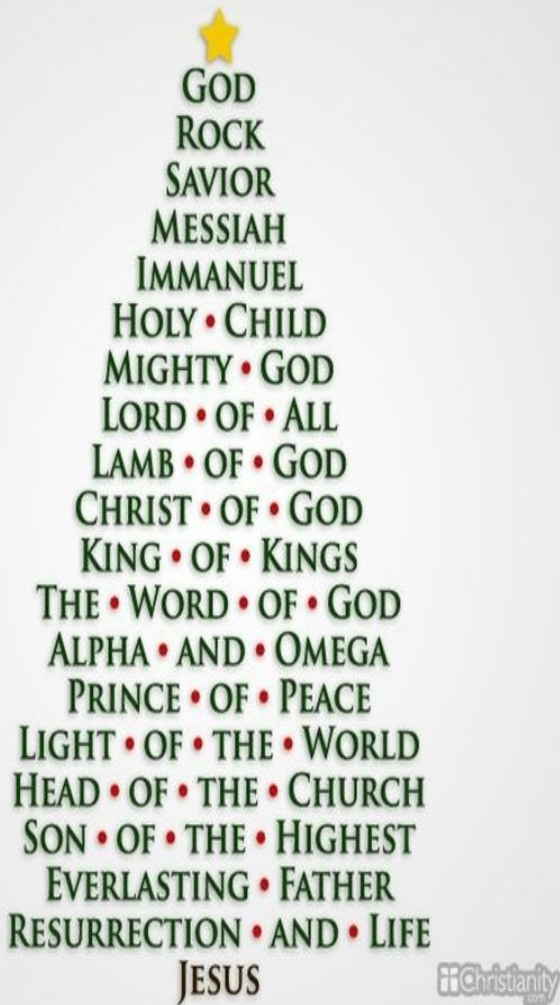
