Worldwide, 795 million people are hungry. Nearly 1 in 10 people live on less than \$2 a day. Poor nutrition causes nearly half of all the deaths in children under 5. Every day, over 7,000 kids die from hunger related causes. It would take \$3.2 billion to help all 66 million hungry school-aged children in the developing world. 
What is CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate)?

CASA works with children to help end the cycle of abuse and neglect for hundreds of children in York County.

CASA Gives a Voice to a Child in Need

Volunteers through CASA work to ensure each child's best interests are heard and to advocate on behalf of the abused and neglected children of our communities.

The mission of York County CASA Program is to advocate for what is in the best interest of abused and neglected dependent children in the York County court system. CASA is comprised of volunteers who are selected, trained, and guided to help these vulnerable children.
