GROCERY CARD PROGRAM

Several people have asked how the Grocery Card program works. Here's how:

When the church purchases cards we receive an additional 5% in cards. Example: if we pay for \$1000 worth of cards, we get \$1050. The \$50 is our profit. You purchase the cards at face value and use them for your regular shopping. You can use multiple cards to pay for your grocery purchase.

If your card(s) is/are of greater value than you purchase, the balance remains on your card for the next shopping trip. (You can usually ask the cashier to put a sticker on the card with the remaining balance.) The balance also appears on your receipt.

If your purchase is more than the total amount available on your cards, the remaining balance is to be paid by cash, check, credit, or debit card.

Grocery Cards are available for Weis or Giant in amounts ranging from \$10 to \$100, and can be purchased by cash or check (church members) from Dick or Karen Hamilton, Karen Hoover, or any time during normal church office hours from Allison.
